## FALL 2022 TRANSFER ADMISSION GUARANTEE

### AM I ELIGIBLE FOR A TAG?

\_\_ You must meet the definition of a California Community College (CCC) student

- You have been enrolled at one or more CCCs for at least 2 regular terms (excludes summer sessions)
- You are attending a CCC as your last college before transfer (excludes summer sessions) and in good standing

\_\_ You must meet the following unit requirements for fall 2022 admission:

- Complete 60 semester (90 quarter) UC-transferable units
  - By the end of summer 2021: Complete 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units (may include AP/IB units)
  - By the end of spring 2022: Complete 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units at one or more CCC's

\_\_ You must complete the following 7-course pattern by the end of spring 2022 for fall 2022 admission, earning a grade of "C" or better in each course:

- Two UC-transferable English Composition courses
- One UC-transferable Math course
- Four UC-transferable courses from two of the following three areas: Arts/Humanities, Social/Behavioral Sciences and Physical/Biological Sciences

### HOW DO I APPLY FOR A UCM TAG?

\_\_ Use the UC Transfer Admission Planner (TAP) at (<https://uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu>) to complete the online UC TAG application and self-report your full academic history from all colleges/universities you have attended

\_\_ Submit an online UC TAG application between **September 1-30, 2021** (you can only apply for a TAG at **one** campus)

\_\_ Submit a UC admission application to UCM at ([apply.universityofcalifornia.edu](http://apply.universityofcalifornia.edu)) between **November 1-30, 2021** (for the same major as the TAG application)

### LIMITATIONS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

\_\_ No unrepeatable grade(s) of "No Pass", "D" or "F" in UC transferable courses

\_\_ No more than two total withdrawals in major preparation courses

\_\_ Student must be enrolled at a CCC full-time (contact office of admissions for questions about part time status)

\_\_ Applicants can have no more than one major preparation course where grades of "No Pass", "D" or "F" were received even if repeated with passing grades.

\_\_ If you have taken any courses at a four-year university, you may not reach or exceed 80 semester (120 quarter) units of combined CCC lower division and four-year upper division units.

\_\_ TAG is available to International students with domestic and international coursework as well as AB540 students.

International students must also meet English proficiency requirements (<http://admissions.ucmerced.edu/international-transfer-applicants>) for UCM.
